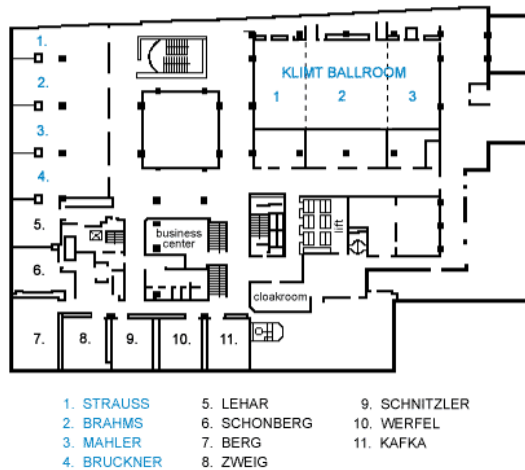

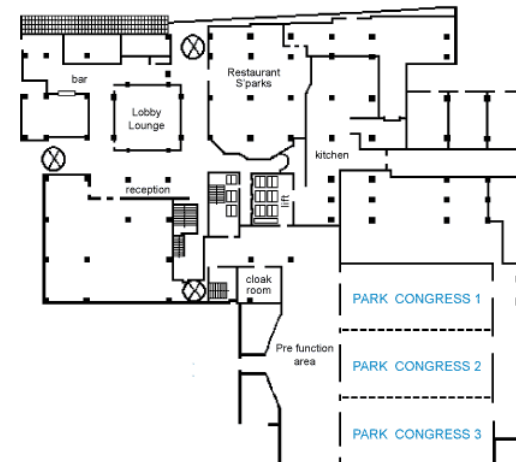

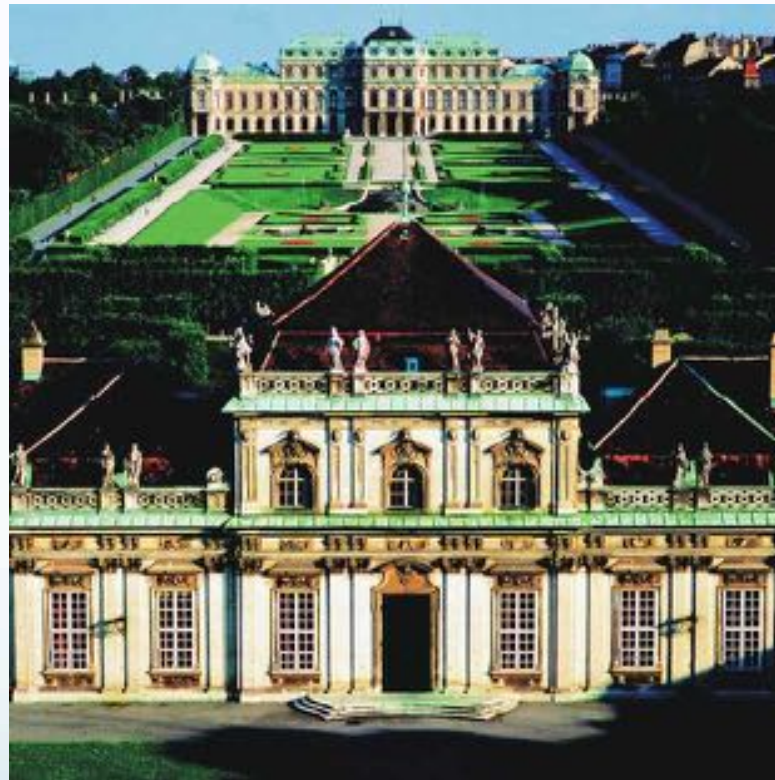

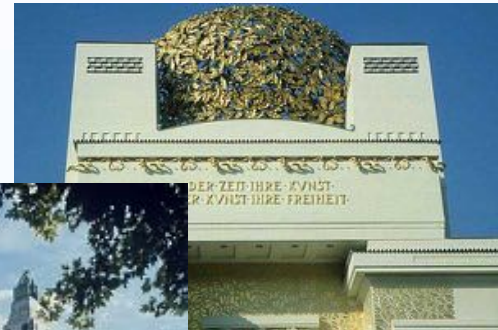

TCCA Budget Calculation

- Old model
 - Based completely on conference surpluses
- New model
 - 1/3 of conference surplus to TC
 - 1/3 of conference surplus back to conference
 - A percentage of TC budget surplus (carryover) returned to TC



2017 Allocation

- Due to conference surplus: \$72,822
- Carryover: \$3,856

TCCA Young Computer Architect Award



Eligibility:

“The award is open to any individual who has completed his/her PhD degree after March 15, 2011 (within last 6 years). **At the discretion of the awards committee, eligibility may be adjusted for documented family-related or medical leaves from employment.** The winner of the award will be someone who has made an outstanding, innovative research contribution or contributions to the field of Computer Architecture.”

 - **In recognition of:** *“outstanding research contributions in mobile computing and resilient architectures”*
- 2017 – Nominations to be accepted soon.
